- For orders of 10 or more books, there is a 50% Author Event discount, and any unsold books may be returned (if they are in their original condition).
- Please send your order as soon as possible, optimally several weeks in advance of the event, to avoid a potential surcharge for expedited shipping.

More detailed information (addressing questions from people who have placed orders in the past)

- OUP's list price for the paperback is \$16.95, so the discounted price is \$8.48.
- Shipping and handling ("S&H") costs are extra; they will vary depending on the shipping speed and the weight of the package. By way of example, a non-expedited order of 20 books sent to NYC cost \$14 for S&H.
- For shipments to many states, sales tax must also be charged, at that state's sales tax rate. If the customer is exempt from sales tax, it must supply a state tax exemption certificate at the time it places the order (not afterwards).
- OUP recommends placing your order 4 weeks in advance of when you want the books to arrive at any U.S. destination (and 8 weeks in advance for any destination outside the U.S.). Orders placed less far in advance can still be delivered on time, but they might involve a surcharge for expedited shipping.
- You may sell the book for any price you choose. If you prefer to sell books only for cash, you may select a price that facilitates cash purchases. (For example, taking into account S&H and tax costs, books could be sold for \$10.)
- If you wish to enlist a local bookstore to sell books at your event, please be advised that significant staffing and financial resources go into facilitating bookstores' offsite book sales. Therefore, many bookstores have set a minimum number of books they require to be sold at an event before they will provide staffing. If you are interested in exploring whether your local bookstore or campus bookshop could handle book sales for your event, we recommend that you reach out 6-8 weeks in advance to discuss this.
