Bringing human rights abuses to light and holding responsible those who allegedly ordered or carried them out starts with an investigation. How does a human rights group decide whether to look into alleged abuses? What broad steps does it take to prepare for an investigation? How do investigators collect evidence and take eyewitnesses' testimonies? And what considerations are involved when putting together an official report?

Michael Garcia Bochenek—senior counsel to the Children's Rights Division of Human Rights Watch, and lead author of several investigative reports, including *Like We Were Just Animals* in 2023 concerning Croatia's policy of pushing back asylum seekers to Bosnia and Herzegovina—will discuss these questions and others during this lunch conversation.
